

Dial-A-Ride

Dial-A-Ride is **curb to curb shared-ride transportation**, scheduled by appointment and managed by MV Transit under contract with the City of West Hollywood. Shopping shuttle is available weekly.

Best used for:

- Medium to longer trips in
 West Hollywood and surrounding areas
- Medical appointments, personal appointments, shopping
- Appointments with advance notice

Eligibility: West Hollywood residents 62 and over or disabled of any age.

Area: West Hollywood and immediate area, Kaiser @ Cadillac and Sunset, UCLA Medical Center, Veteran's Hospital and West Hollywood social services agencies.

Schedule: Monday through Friday, 7:30 am - 5:30 pm (last pickup at 4:45)

Taxi Program

The City of West Hollywood offers a taxi subsidy card for use with regular City taxis.

Best used for:

- Medium length trips in West Hollywood and immediate area
- Medical appointments and personal appointments
- Weekend and evening trips and unplanned trips
- Medium cost option may require out of pocket cost

Eligibility: West Hollywood residents 62 and over or who are disabled of any age. Area: West Hollywood and Los Angeles Schedule: 24 hours. Call taxi company for pick up. It is helpful to request a "West Hollywood" cab if you are outside the City

Cost: \$28 fare value costs \$8

There is a **cap of \$14** per trip – may have out of pocket cost.
