

73rd ANNIVERSARY OF VICTORY IN EUROPE DAY

Immortal Regiment March

Sunday, May 6, 2018 Activities Begin at 9:30 AM



Victory in Europe Day marks the defeat of the Nazi forces and remembers the estimated 50 million people who died during World War II. The Immortal Regiment march was initially held by volunteers in the Russian city of Tomsk to mark the anniversary of the Victory in WWII, and has since grown to become a global movement. The Immortal Regiment marches, which will take place from May 6-9 this year, are an act of admiration and remembrance of all who fought against the Nazis during the WWII. Participants honor their relatives who fought the Nazis in WWII by carrying placards with photos of their relatives.

Immortal Regiment activities had 12 million participants in Russia last year. These marches go beyond politics; they show that we will always be grateful for WWII veterans, and that we will never forget the sacrifices they made. With fascism on the rise worldwide, the Immortal Regiment march has taken on a new and urgent meaning, as it honors the soldiers who fought and many who perished in the fight against fascism.

This year's Immortal Regiment march will begin at the intersection of Santa Monica Boulevard and Fairfax Avenue. Participants are encouraged to bring portraits of family members, friends, or loved ones who participated in WWII. *Parking will not be provided.*

Following the Immortal Regiment march, three memorial benches will be unveiled to kick off the annual Victory in Europe Day celebration. Three West Hollywood community members and veterans of WWII, Mr. Yefim Stolyarsky, Mr. Efim Kutz, and Mr. Vladimir Barkon will be honored through the unveiling of these memorial benches. The three significant community leaders helped lead the Los Angeles Association of Veterans of WWII, an organization founded in 1977 in a WWII veteran's West Hollywood apartment as a way to socialize and preserve the legacy of veterans. Their accomplishments are invaluable to West Hollywood and the Russian-speaking community. At the meeting on December 19, 2017, the Russian Advisory Board voted to approve benches with a memorial plaque in honor of these men and their service to the community.

11:30 AM – Victory in Europe Day Memorial Celebration - Plummer Park, Fiesta Hall (7377 Santa Monica Boulevard)

Bring portraits of your family members, friends, or loved ones who participated in World War II. Please do not bring flags and other posters to the march! Please gather at the intersection of Santa Monica Boulevard and Fairfax Avenue (Whole Foods Plaza side). Parking will not be provided. Parking at Whole Foods Plaza is prohibited!

The march will start at 9:30 sharp, please plan accordingly and arrive early.

Veterans and people who are unable to walk and who are participating in the march may ride on a bus, which departs from Plummer Park (South Parking Lot off Santa Monica Blvd) at 9:00 AM. To get a ride on a bus you need to RSVP at 323-848-6501.

After the march, people may gather, lay flowers and wreaths at the Veterans Memorial in Plummer Park to be followed by a Victory in Europe Day Memorial Celebration at **11:30 AM** in Fiesta Hall, Plummer Park, 7377 Santa Monica Boulevard, West Hollywood, CA 90046.
