## 2.M. PROHIBITION OF ANIMAL COMPANIONS AT WEST HOLLYWOOD ANNUAL HALLOWEEN CARNAVAL [J. PRANG, J. STEVENS, S. GUARRIELLO, D. SAUR]:

The City Council will consider directing the City attorney to research the feasibility of drafting an ordinance prohibiting the presence of animal companions at future West Hollywood Halloween Carnavals.
