


Selected Pattern:







- 1. Compatible with storefronts

 - Melrose/Robertson 30-40' tall x 25-30' wide
 - Beverly 40-50' tall x 30' wide
- 3. Unique to Avenues/diversity
- 4. Adequate soil volume
- 5. Adequate water




Beverly:

All 20' high with 6' banners










Roadway + Low-Level Examples




