



Transportation Commission

Outstanding Accomplishments

- The Commission received, gave input on, and reviewed various reports and work plans in preparation of the finalization of the General Plan.
- Neighborhood Traffic Calming: Reviewed, public testimony taken, and projects implemented after City Council approvals on the installation of a test traffic Circle Street at Cynthia and Larrabee Street.

Parking

- o Recommended draft legislation to the City Council, "An Ordinance Of The City Of West Hollywood Creating A Parking Credits Program And Designating Parking Credits Districts."
- o Recommended to the City Council an interim two-hour time limit on the south side of Doheny Road, between Sunset Boulevard and the West Hollywood / Beverly Hills western city border; and the east and west sides of Sunset Hills Road, as a six-month trial between the hours of 7 a.m. to 7 p.m., seven days a week.
- o Directed staff to provide the Transportation Commission and the City Council with a report after the six-month trial period that includes an analysis to determine the feasibility of making the trial regulations permanent.
- o Discussed details of a proposed agreement and provided recommendation to Council to enter into an agreement with ECotality to install electric vehicle charging stations.
- o Recommended to City Council to authorize the City Manager to enter into an agreement with Zipcar to provide a car-sharing pilot program for a period of two years.

Transit and Taxi Services

- o Approved the recommendation for a Five Year Extension to the current Taxicab Franchise Agreement.
- o Gave input on the analysis of Cityline Shuttle Service and Route Options.
- o Gave input on the Entertainment Shuttle Program.
- o Received reports on Potential Funding for Cityline Service Expansion.

Pedestrian and Bicycle

- o Collaborated with Public Safety Subcommittee on pedestrian safety issues, Traffic/Enforcement issues and Bicycles on Sidewalks.
- o The removal / relocation of landscape and / or signage, including flag poles at 7 locations and work with Public Facilities to beautify affected areas.
- o Received a presentation from Bikestation.
- o Received a presentation from SoCal Bike Share.
- o Worked with and received reports from Bicycle Task Force.
- o Recommended to the City Council the approval of bicycle improvement projects.
- o Considered various potential pedestrian design treatments at unsignalized crosswalks for further evaluation as part of the General Plan's vision.
- o Received a report on the Amendment to the Zoning Ordinance Regarding the Standards for Bicycle Parking.
- o Considered the Amendment of Bicycle Design Standards in the Citywide Street Furniture Program.
- o Recommended City Council include the Inverted-U bicycle rack design in the Citywide Street Furniture Program as the preferred bicycle rack design.
- o Received report on Fountain Avenue Bike Route Improvements.
- o Received and discussed Pedestrian Accident Reports.
- o Rectangular Rapid Flashing Beacons at Santa Monica Boulevard and Westmount Drive, as well as two other locations.
- o Recommended installation of Sharrows on Fountain Avenue.
