- Call Social Services at (323) 848-6510 if you observe a person who is homeless whoneeds assistance. An outreach team from PATH will follow up.
- Call the Sheriff's Department at (310) 855-8850 if a person who is homeless is trespassing, harassing, or engaging in other illegal activity.
- If you or someone you know is homeless and wants services, call Social Services at the number above, or come in to City Hall during business hours.
- If you are a business or property owner, call the Sheriff's Department to file a Letter of Agency which authorizes entry to your property if there is a report of illegal activity.
