Fee Rebate Application Instructions

You are eligible for rent registration fee rebates if all the following statements apply to you:

- Your landlord paid the registration fees for the building to the City
- You were a West Hollywood rent stabilized tenant between September 1, 2021 & August 31, 2024
- You are at least 62 years of age or disabled
- Your household annual income does not exceed the area's Very Low Income standard set by HUD

IMPORTANT FOR APPLICATION SUBMISSION:

Documentation that proves eligibility for the fee rebate **MUST** be provided at the time of submission. For details about acceptable documentation, read below.

Residence

List the address and apartment number for which the fee rebate is claimed. Supporting documentation showing the applicant lived in the unit during the relevant rebate period must be attached.

Examples of acceptable documentation are **photocopies** of one of the following:

- Original lease or rental agreement
- Receipts or cancelled checks for relevant rent payments
- Utility bills showing the service in the applicant's name during the relevant time period.

Income information

Check "Yes" or "No" to indicate if the applicant's household income was below the Very Low Income standard set by HUD for the relevant time period.

Examples of acceptable documentation are **photocopies** of one of the following:

- Award letters from Social Security
- Bank statements showing the direct deposit of benefits, pension checks, and tax returns

Applicant information

- List the applicant's name, mailing address and phone number, as well as the number of persons living in the applicant's household.
- List the date the applicant turned 62 or the date the applicant became disabled. If 62 or older, evidence such as a copy of the applicant driver's license, state ID, bus pass ID, birth certificate, or passport must be provided to prove age.
- If living with a disability, evidence such as a copy of a disability benefits award letter or a written statement from the applicant's physician must be provided to prove disability.

Applicant declaration

Check "Yes" or "No" to indicate that the following was paid to the landlord:

- \$6 monthly tenant portion of the registration for the months of July 2021 through August 2024

Declare under penalty of perjury that all information provided in this application is true, correct, and complete by signing and dating the application on the appropriate line.
