- Hire a licensed, uniform security guard assigned to 2. the establishment's parking lot or to the parking lots that accommodate the patrons;

- 3. Prohibit patrons under 21 years of age from entering the establishment those nights when the licensee is conducting adult entertainment.
- 4. Receive an approved business license subject to a six-month review either by the Commission or by City staff.
