Action: To approve an Outdoor Festival license for the City of West Hollywood to conduct their annual Street Festival with the following conditions:

- 1) Recommendations for approval must be given by the City's Building and Safety and Planning Division, and the County's Fire, Health and Sheriff's Departments before the release of the Outdoor Festival license.
- 2) The applicant must secure a Temporary Use Permit from the City's Planning Division.
- 3) The hours of operation for the event shall be from 10:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m. on October 15, 1988, and from 10:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m. on October 16, 1988.
- The applicant agrees to comply with the provisions of the City's Noise Ordinance (Article IV, Ch.3, WHMC).
- 5) The applicant shall only allow to be consumed on the premises those alcoholic beverages specifically sold by the applicant on the Festival grounds. No bottles or cans of alcoholic beverages are allowed on the Festival grounds and alcoholic beverages served are restricted to beer and wine only. Alcohlic beverages must be paid for with tickets purchased at a separate location on the Festival grounds.
- 6) The applicant agrees to provide off-site parking spaces at the Pacific design Center for Festival staff, vendors and guests and to provide shuttle service to and from the Festival site.

7) That the Commission waive the current Outdoor Festival license requirements for parking, drinking fountain facilities, the prohibition of the sale of alcoholic beverages and the mailing of notices to property owners within a 500 foot radius of the event, as indicted in this staff report.
