APPLICANT TESTIMONY:

Bobbi Griffey, Santa Monica

Action: To approve an Outdoor Festival business license application for the Asian Pacific American Legal Center, Inc. to conduct an Asian Pacific Festival and Culinary Carnival on San Vicente Blvd., between Santa Monica Blvd. and Melrose Ave., on May 20 and 21, 1989, with the following conditions:

1) Recommendation for approval must be given by the City's Building and Safety Division and the County Fire, Health and Sheriff's Departments, before release of the Outdoor Festival license and the conduct of the Festival;

- The hours of operation for the event shall be from noon to 11:00 p.m. on Saturday, May 20, 1989, and from noon to 10:00 p.m. on Sunday, May 21, 1989;
- The applicant must not violate the provisions of the City's Noise Ordinnace as set forth in Section 4300 of the West Hollywood Municipal Code;
- 4) The applicant shall allow no more than a combined total of 30,000 persons into the Festival area during the two days of the Festival;
- 5) The applicant agrees to provide off-site parking spaces for festival staff, vendors and guests equal to one-tenth of the number of festival guests allowed by the license;
- The applicant shall submit a letter from the Pacific Design Center stating that the Pacific Design Center has agreed to allow the Asian Pacific Festival and Culinary Carnival to use the parking structure owned and operated by the Pacific Design Center for parking for festival vendors and guests. The letter shall also state the hours the parking structure shall be opened, the cost for parking of each vehicle and the number of spaces available;
- 7) The applicant shall only allow to be consumed on the premises those alcoholic beverages specifically sold by the applicant on the festival grounds. No bottles or cans of alcoholic beverages are allowed on the festival grounds and alocholic beverages served are restricted to beer and wine only. Alcoholic beverages must be paid for with tickets purchased at a separate location on the festival grounds;
- The applicant shall submit a site plan showing the location of the proposed festival, and the location of the staging area, loudspeakers, toilet facilities, interior access, medical facilities and drinking facilities;
- The Commission waive the current Outdoor Festival license requirements for parking, drinking fountain facilities, the prohibition of the sale of alcoholic beverages and the mailing of notices to property owners within a 500' radius of the event.
