### FACTS

- Orange Grove Ave and Ogden Dr crosswalks have high levels of pedestrians.
- Santa Monica Blvd and Fairfax Ave have very high auto traffic.

### CHALLENGES

- High traffic on Santa Monica Blvd impacts pedestrian safety.
- High pedestrian traffic impacts traffic flow of cars.
- The Orange Grove crosswalk is very close to Fairfax Ave and causes traffic backups.

### PROPOSED CHANGES

- Remove the two existing *uncontrolled crosswalks* and install a new *signalized crosswalk*.
- New signalized crosswalk improves pedestrian safety.
- New signal can be coordinated with nearby traffic signals to improve traffic flow.

Remove 2 unsignalized crosswalks & install 1 new signal
