NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Request For Qualifications, (RFQ), submissions from professional artists and/or artist teams residing in the United States may be submitted for a temporary land art exhibition, *Can You Dig It?*.

The purpose of the RFQ process is to identify qualified artists meeting the City's criteria and instructions outlined in the RFQ document. Qualified artists will receive a notice of eligibility to participate in the City's proposal process.

Replies to the RFQ will be accepted online up until the hour of 5:00 p.m. on Wednesday, August 26, 2015.

Applications must be uploaded in the format outlined in the City's RFQ document to be considered.

Requests For Proposal (RFP) instructions will be released at a later date to artist finalists identified by the selection committee. Only those artists selected under the RFQ will be invited to submit proposals.
