For each update cycle, the State gives each City housing which represent the City's "fair share" of projected housing for that period. Cities are then required to update the Housin ement to accommodate any new policy or program changes red to address the State's mandate.	need ng El-

Mixed Use in the City's 2000-2005 Housing Element

The City's Housing Element recommends additional incentives for mixed-use development (ex: housing above retail) to achieve a diversity of housing options. Mixed-use also create pedestrian-oriented districts where residents can walk to commercial activities. Staff is currently working on the Mixed-use Overlay Zone for the City's eastside.
