West Hollywood wins NEA grant

In its second major grant announcement of Fiscal Year 2015, the National Endowment for the Arts (NEA) will make a \$10,000 award to the city of West Hollywood to support its One City One Pride LGBTQ Arts Festival in 2016. The NEA will make 1,023 awards totaling \$74.3 million nationwide in this funding round.

Each year, the city's One City One Pride LGBTQ Arts Festival celebrates the artistic contributions of the LGBTQ community with special programming. This year, in celebration of West Hollywood's 30th anniversary of cityhood, One City One Pride will examine what it means to turn 30 with the theme "WeHo@30, Life@30". The festival will run 40 days from May 22, to honor Harvey Milk Day, through June 30, which marks the end of Pride month.
