Minimum Qualifications

The City of West Hollywood (CITY) is seeking a qualified firm to provide Utility Audit – Cost Recovery/Cost Containment. To be considered for this contract, your firm must meet the qualifications and satisfy the requirements as stated in the Request for Proposal (RFP).

Contractor must be a responsible firm that has been in continuous existence and has provided continuous services for the relevant requirements contained herein for at least five (5) years. Less than the minimum required experience will eliminate that proposer from further consideration.

Fees

There will be no up-front fees or any charges to the City. City plans to pay for these consulting services as fees, which will be paid as a percentage of the refunds and savings, identified by the consultant, and only after City actually receives these refunds and savings and only for a period negotiated between the City and the Energy Consultant.

It shall be mandatory upon the Contractor to whom the contract is awarded and upon any subcontractor under them to pay not less than said specified rates to all workers employed by them in the execution of the contract as applicable. Compliance with the City of West Hollywood Living Wage Ordinance is also required.
