- American Red Cross Water Safety Instructor Certification (must obtain within 6 months of hire)

- **All required current American Red Cross certifications must be submitted with the application. Failure to submit copies of all required certifications with the application will result in the rejection of your application.**
- Candidates 18 or older must complete a criminal background questionnaire as part of the application process.
- Candidates selected for hire will be required to successfully complete a City-paid physical and background check.
- A Lifeguard Skills Test will be administered as part of the selection process.
- All certifications must be maintained throughout employment in order to remain in the position.
