C. CONNECT PROGRAM

The Board heard a presentation from Terry Shajirat, coordinator of Jewish Family Service's CONNECT Program, and volunteer Allison Scott. The program matches seniors and adults with disabilities with volunteers who assist with transportation and other needs, while creating meaningful relationships that reduce social isolation.

B. ARTS AND CULTURAL AFFAIRS PROGRAMS

Joy Nuell agreed with Pat Dixon's idea for the City to offer more activities.

Vice-Chair Levin expressed dissatisfaction about her living situation. She also recommended a film that addresses issues with Alzheimers' disease.

Chair Walkup would like the effects of Costa-Hawkins and Ellis Acts to be placed on a future agenda. He announced that he is going to Denver to attend the International Choral Festival and that he is running as a delegate for the Democratic Convention.

Corey Roskin distributed direct deposit forms for those Board members who want to sign up. He also announced potential dates for the pharmaceutical drug pricing town hall meeting on either Wednesday, September 14 or Wednesday, September 21.
