

Methods and Findings of the Telephone Survey

Methodology


- O Survey conducted January 17-31, 2016
- Telephone-based random voter survey (landlines and cell phones)
- Interviews with a random sample of 400 West Hollywood residents
- O Survey was available in English, Russian, and Spanish
- Overall Margin of Error: +/- 4.9% for half the sample is +/- 7.0%
- Some percentages may not sum to 100% due to rounding

Traffic is the most prominent concern, followed by affordable housing and parking; the lowest numbers consider crime a serious issue.




When asked directly, homelessness, unsafe driving, and pedestrian safety rank as the most serious public safety problems facing the City. Total Ser.


(Ranked by Very Serious Problem)




There is less concern about violent crime or hate-related crime, albeit 1 in 3 or more consider these issues serious.




By nearly a 5-to-1 margin, residents have a positive impression of West Hollywood's Sheriff's deputies.




West Hollywood's firefighters get overwhelmingly favorable reviews from those familiar.




Nearly nine in ten residents trust the West Hollywood Sheriff's deputies to protect them and their families, with more than half saying they trust them a great deal.




West Hollywood's Sheriff's Department employees get high marks in all specific areas tested, including response times, effectiveness, and professional treatment of all people.




Half of residents surveyed have had contact with West Hollywood's Sheriff's deputies in the past two years.




The Sheriff's deputies get high marks for all aspects of their performance from those who have had contact.




Six in ten are satisfied with the Sheriff's efforts to communicate with them through the mail, internet or other means.



West Hollywood residents consider a text alert, email, letter, or postcard to be the most effective ways to reach them personally with information about West Hollywood public safety-related issues. Total




Lower numbers turn to meetings, newspapers, or local television.

Overall Outreach Findings

Summary Of Findings From All Outreach Methods

Major Findings From Overall Outreach

- Public safety in West Hollywood is perceived as good/very good
- O Concerns over crime are very low
- Issues of greatest concern
 - Homelessness
 - Pedestrian and traffic safety



State of Public Safety in West Hollywood

Telephone Survey

- Compared to other public issues, concern about crime is low
- Less than half (49%) consider it a serious problem
- Homelessness and pedestrian/traffic safety are of high concern

State of Public Safety in West Hollywood (Continued)

Overall, Public Safety is not a pressing issue

Safer than neighboring cities

Homelessness and pedestrian safety are concerns

Rated safety as excellent/

Statistically safe, feels unsafe
