Sofia Gelman expressed her concerns about preserving historical information regarding the Russian community and Russian heritage.

Pat Dixon stated that she attended the Arts and Cultural Affairs Commission last week and found it very interesting. She also discussed an article in the LA Times that talked about happiness and aging, which in turn led to discussion about seniors and loneliness. Subsequently, a presentation/discussion on seniors/loneliness at an upcoming SAB meeting was requested. Staff will follow up in that regard.

Chair Walkup spoke about the following:

- 1) Governor Brown signed legislation regarding access to PrEP/PEP.
- 2) The Library of Congress is now being headed by a senior!
- 3) Empty pill boxes can be taken to Capitol Drugs to be recycled.
- 4) By next year, same day registration for voting on election days will take place in California.
- 5) The City's Annual Board & Congress event will take place on Saturday, October 29.
- 6) Lee expressed the importance of Measure MM on the upcoming ballot.

Corey Roskin followed up with the SAB regarding two items that board member Sofia Gelman brought up at the August SAB meeting regarding removal & replacement of trees in Plummer Park and the temporary location of a metro stop on the south side of Santa Monica Blvd./Fuller Ave.
