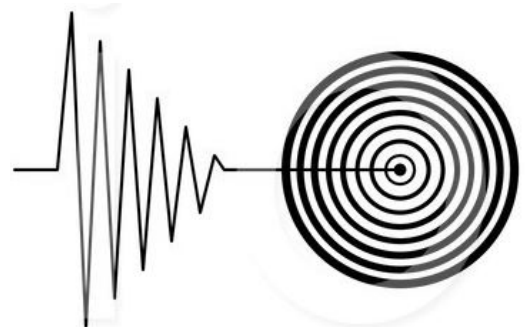

About a Proposed Ordinance to
Strengthen Soft/Weak Story Buildings



West Hollywood takes a proactive approach to earthquake safety. Our goal is to help protect people and minimize damage in the event of a major earthquake.

The City is developing a mandatory Seismic Retrofit ordinance intended at strengthening existing Soft/Weak Story Buildings. Historically, these buildings have not performed well during major seismic events. The ordinance will be considered by the West Hollywood City Council.

We encourage you to attend a Community Meeting to share your thoughts and ideas.

While no building is absolutely earthquake-proof, retrofitting existing buildings will help protect buildings and the safety of people in them.
