This position manages large, complex, current planning projects, including: reviewing and processing current and legislative projects and major and minor permits and variances; conducting research and gathering information to determine compliance with ordinances and regulations; and requires a strong understanding of CEQA requirements. Political sensitivity and an understanding of the importance of protecting the quality of life for our residents while balancing the needs of the business community and representing the values of the City is essential.

- Bachelor's degree from an accredited four-year college or university in a related field; Master's degree in related field is preferable; and,
- Five (5) to seven (7) years of progressively responsible experience; or, any combination of education, training and experience which provides the required knowledge, skills, and abilities to perform the essential functions of the job.
