CALL TO ORDER: Chair Kurpies called the meeting to order at 7:04 p.m.

An item will be agendized for the January 11, 2018 meeting to consider forming a sub-committee to study various types of proactive code enforcement currently used by cities and report back to the full Commission on a possible recommendation for the City Council to explore a program in West Hollywood.

B. <u>Annual Housing Report:</u> Staff presented the 2016 annual housing report and answered questions from the Commission.
