Commissioner Sunnanon inquired about the future of the palm trees once they are removed. Staff responded by saying that the palm trees will be relocated within the city. He went on to ask what the financial impact will be on the City to relocate the trees. Staff informed the commission that The Grafton will be responsible for the financial impact.

Commissioner Torres asked for clarification in regard to parking not being affected by the expansion of the sidewalk. She also inquired about the timeline of the project and about the impact it will have on traffic.

Commissioner Bowen inquired about the City's tree zones. He also inquired if the transfer of palm trees is safe.

Commissioner Millan expressed concern regarding the replacement of only 3 trees rather than all 4. He inquired about other creative ways to add additional greenery other than trees.

Vice Chair Dolan spoke in favor of the double left turn lane that is part of the proposed plan. He also inquired about the Magnolia trees and asked how long they flower in his discussion relating to the broader context of the projects upgrades in beautification and shade.

Chair Rodriguez spoke about the placement of the red curb on the proposed plan.

He expressed his opposition to having a parkway in front of The Grafton to allow for maximum pedestrian walking space. Chair Rodriguez spoke about the West Hollywood dog parks and thanked the Department of Public Works for the new sidewalks at West Hollywood West.
