B. Senate Amendment 2884, (Stabenow)The HEART for Women amendment
The HEART for Women amendment would add provisions to the Senate health care legislation to address the disparities in the diagnosis and treatment of the #1 killer of American women, heart disease and stroke. Senator Stabenow's amendment would add provisions of the HEART for Women Act to the Senate health reform legislation.
