Applicants must possess the following certification:

- Current and valid Lifeguard and First Aid Certification
- Current and valid CPR/AED for the Professional Rescuer Certification
- Current and valid Water Safety Instructor/Swim Instructor Certification
- Current and valid Lifeguard Instructor Certification
- Current and valid Oxygen Administration Certification

The above certifications can be from Star Guard Lifeguard Certification, American Red Cross, Ellis & Associates (E&A), NASCO and the YMCA.

Please note:

- Candidates 18 years of age or older must complete a CPR Code 5164 Supplemental Questionnaire prior to the time of hire.
- A Lifeguard Skills Test will be administered as part of the selection process.
- The certifications listed above **must be included** with the application or the application will be deemed **incomplete**
