The City is also proposing a new fee to charge for purchasing "No Parking" signs to be installed on City streets during a variety of activities that require reserving parking spaces for a specific use or activity and for the benefit of one or more individual(s) or companies subject to the review and approval of the Public Works Department.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN the City Council of the City of West Hollywood has caused a written report to be prepared and filed with the City Clerk regarding the above-mentioned fees for fiscal year 2018-2019.

NOTICE IS HEREBY FURTHER GIVEN that on the **19<sup>th</sup> day of February, 2019 at or after 6:30 P.M.** in the West Hollywood Public Meeting Room – Council Chambers, 625 N. San Vicente Boulevard, West Hollywood, California 90069, a public hearing will be held on the above-described report. The report is on file in the office of the City Clerk, 8300 Santa Monica Boulevard, West Hollywood, California 90069 and available for public inspection.

At the public hearing, the City Council will hear and consider all objections or protests to the report and the proposed fees. In addition, you may mail or deliver a written protest against the proposed fees to the City Clerk at West Hollywood City Hall, 8300 Santa Monica Boulevard, West Hollywood, California 90069. The City Clerk must receive written protests that have been mailed or delivered to City Hall by 4:00 p.m. on February 19<sup>th</sup>, 2019 to be counted. Written protests may also be delivered to the City Clerk at the public hearing.
