Lee Walkup mentioned the City's WeHo Reads event with Ivy Bottini that will take place on Wednesday, January 16, 2019.


12. ITEMS FROM STAFF

David Giugni thanked the Senior Advisory Board for their work throughout the year.


13. ADJOURNMENT
