with disabilities at any age, and are provided at minimal or no cost.



## On-Call Transportation (310) 981-9303

Available on short notice, without advance reservations.

#### ADVANCE REGISTRATION REQUIRED

Ready 24/7, pickup within 15 minutes.

Great for weekend and evening trips, or unplanned trips.

Request rides by phone, app, or online.

ADA vehicles available.

#### SERVICE AREA

Up to a 10 mile radius from the borders of the City of West Hollywood.

COST

\$8 for \$50 of service credit or \$16 for \$100 per month



## **Metro Bus Pass Subsidy**

The City of West Hollywood provides free 30-day Metro bus passes to senior and/or disabled Metro TAP card holders.

Residents may sign up for the City's subsidy program at West Hollywood City Hall with proof of WeHo residency and Orange Senior/Disabled TAP Card.

Free shared-ride transportation service.

ADVANCE REGISTRATION REQUIRED CALL MON-FRI, 7AM-7PM

Trips scheduled by appointment only. Call up to 1 week ahead.

Use for local trips in West Hollywood and surrounding areas, medical and other appointments, and shopping trips.

Regular shuttles provide trips for grocery shopping, to UCLA Medical Center, and VA West Los Angeles.

All vehicles are ADA accessible. Curb-to-Curb and Door-to-Door options available.

#### SERVICE AREA

West Hollywood and immediate area, UCLA, VA, Kaiser (Cadillac and Sunset) and West Hollywood social service agencies.

#### CITYLINE LOCAL AND COMMUTER SERVICE

The City of West Hollywood's free, fixed route shuttle is great for short trips to the library, grocery stores, parks, the post office, City Hall, and Cedars-Sinai.

Connections to Metro bus and rail service.

Serves West Hollywood City limits, Hollywood/Highland, and Cedars-Sinai.

Stops within ¼ mile of most locations in the City.
