A. Installation of Bike Lanes on Santa Monica Boulevard Between Almont Drive and Doheny Drive

Staff report from Hany Dimitri

ACTION: Recommend to the City Council to construct bike lanes on both the north and south sides of Santa Monica Boulevard by removing on-street parking on the south side and reduce the width of the center median to accommodate a bike lane on the north side (keep current on-street parking). The Commission also recommends exploring the feasibility of widening the sidewalk on the north side of Santa Monica Blvd.
