A. CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATENESS (COA 004-017):

This request is for proposed renovation and rehabilitation of the existing main house and the chauffer's cottage, creation of thirty-four (34) affordable senior housing units and one (1) manager's unit, and a 9,900 square-foot public park in the northern and eastern portion of the site. The housing units would be located as follows: six (6) in the existing main

house, one (1) in the chauffer's cottage and twenty-eight (28) in a new building at the southwest portion of the site. Public meeting rooms would be located in the front of the existing main residence. The new building would provide twenty-one (21) subterranean parking spaces and have a height ranging from two to four stories. The existing garages and studio would be removed.

If you challenge any City of West Hollywood decision in court, you may be limited to raising only those issues you or someone else raised at the public hearing described on this agenda, or in a written correspondence delivered to the Historic Preservation Commission at, or prior to, the public hearing.
