**2010s** Appearance of larger residential projects in WeHo West

2013-14 Community feedback via public meetings, website, & working group

**2014** Adoption of new Zoning Overlay and Design Guidelines

**2015-19** Initial implementation on *new* residential projects

2019 Progress review of performance-to-date; Community feedback

**2019-20** Drafting & adoption of updates

## Tools

#### 1. Zoning Overlay

Specific standards that must be complied with.

(e.g., minimums/maximums for building area, height, setbacks, parking, etc.)

#### 2. Design Guidelines

 Wide-ranging recommendations to support neighborhood fit, quality materials, and variety in new construction.

(e.g., shape, massing, style, detailing, doors, windows, colors, finishes, landscaping, etc.)

- 1. Manage change within the West Hollywood West neighborhood;
- 2. Protect desirable qualities and characteristics;
- 3. Enhance the existing eclectic character and quality;
