Additionally, the Recreation Leader II will plan and organize programs and activities, lead summer staff and support the direct supervisor in various administrative and technical functions.

The ideal candidate is passionate about recreation and is motivated and self-directed with strong interpersonal and customer service skills. A demonstrated track record of direct, hands-on experience overseeing recreation programs, educational programs and/or special events, including program planning, budgeting and execution is essential for success in this position.
