- **b. Umberto Capiro**, Designer of project, commented that this project is a low-scale project, on seating area design, and no amplified music.
- c. Ruth Williams, West Hollywood, expressed her concern regarding parking impact and noticing, but stated that she is not opposed to project.
- **d.** Craig Ritchie, West Hollywood, commented that he is upset that there was no neighborhood meeting held and that a better parking plan is needed.
- e. Eddie Pinchasi, West Hollywood, commented that he owns the adjacent car wash and is concerned with parking impact.
- **f. Elizabeth Kolodziey**, West Hollywood, expressed concern regarding parking impact and against outdoor seating.
- g. Joel Mark, West Hollywood, West Hollywood, expressed concern regarding on-going construction at project site and loading in alley.
- h. Jeanne Dobrin, West Hollywood, commented that parks are not for parking use of private business and employees and that the staff report did not have sufficient information.
- i. Todd Elliot, West Hollywood, commented that he is in favor of project, but is concerned about hours of operation, and also on parking availability.

Mr. Dahan and Mr. Capiro rebutted.

### 8. ITEMS FROM COMMISSIONERS

- a. Commissioner Behr stated that the City of South Gate has suspensions on alcohol permits, similar to the Alcohol and Beverage Control. This should be a consideration for the zoning code rewrite.
- b. Commissioner Jones inquired about the recent occurrence at House of Blues and also that records are difficult to find in Planning and Building and Safety Divisions. Mr. Reynolds stated that with the next years budget a records management program will be implemented. Commissioner Behr stated that the City of Burbank has a good Records Department. Mr. Reynolds stated that there was a meeting with House of Blues, where it was decided that additional Sheriffs would patrol during event nights. Captain Odenthal stated that the City would pay these deputies overtime for their additional hours. The Planning Commission directed staff to agendize this item for the next meeting.

Commissioner Jones stated that the Project Area Committee for East Side Redevelopment has finalized a schedule of meeting dates for implementation plan.

Captain Odenthal presented Commissioner Altschul with a commendation from Sheriff Sherman Block for his service on the Public Safety Commission.

- c. Commissioner Litz commented on the California League of Cities Planner's Institute.
- d. Commissioner Altschul inquired about House of Blues parking structure plans. Mr. Reynolds stated that the Transportation and Public Works Department has asked for additional analysis to the traffic study. project. House of Blues is highly anticipating this project and have started construction drawings.

Commissioner Altschul suggested a study session with staff and neighborhood watch leaders.

**e.** Commissioner Fischer stated that she and Commissioner Jones at this morning's Design Review Subcommittee had given direction regarding the project plans.

Commissioner Fischer inquired about a card club on La Cienega. Ms. Heep stated that this was an existing card club and which had no complaints. The club is asking for new permits at a different site. Some tenants in new location are concerned.

Commissioner Fischer inquired about available funds for Planning Commissioners to attend the APA Conference. Ms. Heep stated that there is some available funds from mid-year budget review, and that there could be funds available for the registration, if not more.
