Commissioner Altschul stated that he had a financial interest in Best Western Hotel, which is nearby the project site, but that he felt he could still vote.

Commissioner Smith stated that he had attended a neighborhood meeting and visited the site.

Commissioner Behr stated that he had visited the site.

Commissioner Jones stated that he had a client who was nearby the House of Blues and that he is part of the Design Review Subcommittee.

Ms. Davis presented the staff report.

The Commission discussed the following:

Ms. Dyke answered questions regarding parking spaces, circulation and interim parking plans.

a. Mark Lehman, Applicant, presented the Applicant's report.

The Commission discussed the following:

- b. Beth Grant, General Manager of House of Blues, commented on security and that neighborhood complaints have declined.

The Commission discussed the following:

- capacity/occupancy
- requirement in original CUP to provide parking
- security
- · identification of valet parking company's body of supervision
- Sheriff's expenses
- **c. Si Teller**, Architect, commented on design of structure and its attempt to resolve issues of noise, traffic and parking.

The Commission discussed noise from rooftop parking and design of facade facing residential area.

Councilmember Jeff Prang presented a commendation to James Litz from Kenneth P. Hahn for his service as a Planning Commissioner.

- **d. Kitty Cole**, West Hollywood, commented that the and other residents are discouraged with House of Blues and their lack of responsiveness.
- e. Don Savoie, West Hollywood Chamber of Commerce, commented that the problems at House of Blues (i.e. noise, crime) occur in other areas of West Hollywood as well, and that the issue here is if the garage meets CUP requirements. The new co-chair of the Nightclub Council is Beth Grant.
- f. Tom Lanevin, West Hollywood, commented that he is in favor of the project but architecture should be refined.
- **g. Anthony Policella**, Los Angeles, President of Valet Parking Service, commented on valet service will be improved with the new parking structure.
- h. Kiernan McKiernan, West Hollywood, commented that not all problems in neighborhood have been resolved. Parking structure will resolve only some of the problems. A solution could be to place barricade at the top of Olive Drive.
- i. Jill Schwartz, West Hollywood, expressed support of the parking garage and concern regarding parking costs to patrons may affect successfulness of program and commented that she has seen Sheriff's around the club, but suggested they move more south into residential areas.
- **j. Jeanne Dobrin**, West Hollywood, commented on occupancy, security/contract with Sheriff's, City's history of opposing open space parking structures.
- **k. Budd Kops**, West Hollywood, commented that he is against the approval of the project until all details have been answered, but is generally in favor of the parking structure. Would like a limit on roofftop parking hours to close at 11 pm.
- Bettie Wagner, Los Angeles, expressed concern regarding traffic and facade of parking structure.

Mr. Lehman rebutted.

The Commission discussed and requested the following:

- 1. Department of Transportation to review the circulation pattern of the interim parking plan to see if the reverse pattern would work more efficiently
- 2. staff and City Attorney to review language of setback variance finding to determine if it is adequate
- 3. House off Blues to prepare a noise study to be review by staff and brought back to Commission
- 4. staff re re-word or eliminate Conditions 10, 12 and 15 of draft resolution based on revised design by House of Blues architects
- 5. staff to review Condition 24 for possible re-wording
- 6. House of Blues architects to work on design of south and DeLongpre elevations
- 7. staff to check the availability of Golden Crest Retirement Home parking
- 8. House of Blues to revise interim parking plan to indicate where construction workers will park.
