- **d.** Lawrence Gosenfeld, Los Angeles, commented that if parking structure were being built, he would not object to this project, but is in favor of revocation.
- **e. Peter Spire**, Los Angeles, commented that if this business became the "Players Club" that it would become hip hop night seven days a week.
- f. James Mandelbaum, Los Angeles, commented that he is in favor of revocation with prejudice and would not like a restaurant or nightclub there, and would like future business to have soundproofing and parking.

- **g. Joe Sutton**, Los Angeles, commented that there are traffic problems and would like this site to be something important to the City, not a restaurant or a nightclub.
- h. Clive Baillie, Los Angeles, read letter in support of revocation from Roxbury Road Residents Association.
- i. Marne Carmean, West Hollywood, commented that traffic is problem in area.
- **j. Kitty Cole Chipman**, West Hollywood, commented that a parking structure would resolve problems and that the dancefloor should be on the bottom floor.
- **k. Michael Koren**, West Hollywood, commented that he lives above Billboard Live and has adjusted and that this project could work.
- I. Bettie Wagner, Los Angeles, commented on parking leases and is in favor of revocation with prejudice.
- m. Michelle McGrath, West Hollywood, commented that the neighborhood feels good about Dublins and that the Roxbury site is problematic because the area is maxed out.

- **c.** Commissioner Behr stated that SSP section regarding murals needs to be agendized because residential areas need protection.
- **d.** Commissioner DeLuccio inquired whether the 9000 Sunset appeal was still in progress. Ms. Heep stated that the appeal has been withdrawn.

- e. Commissioner DeLuccio stated that at the last Transportation Commission, they discussed how they could be integrated into the project review process along with the Planning Commission. Mr. Revnolds stated that the Planning Commission/Transportation Commission joint study session will be agendized for discussion at the next Planning Commission.
- f. Commissioner Altschul stated that he visited City Hall all day on Tuesday and saw staff's interaction with the public as well as each other and encouraged other Commissioners to share in this positive experience.
