Commissioner Litz wants to correct the language to show that he not only requested an update on 1106 La Cienega, but that he wants a written historical report on the project.

- B. Commissioner Steve Smith requested that staff work closely with Commissioner Gene Smith to present at the earliest opportunity (determined by Commissioner G. Smith) alternatives and background on planning and legal basis so that the Commission can establish new standards for handicap accessibility on residential construction.
- C. Commissioner Litz complained that chairs used by the Commissioners during meetings are uncomfortable and in disrepair.
- D. Commissioner Litz requested that the Commissioners be informed of neighborhood meetings regarding developments and also notice of appeals on Planning Commission decisions so the Commissioners can decide whether they want to go to City Council meetings or talk to Councilmembers.
- E. Commissioner Behr talked about dilapidated properties that are brought to the Commission for demolition. He requested that the owners of unoccupied properties be forced to barricade those properties under Building and Safety standards. He also requested a name to contact if the Commissioners want access to a property.
