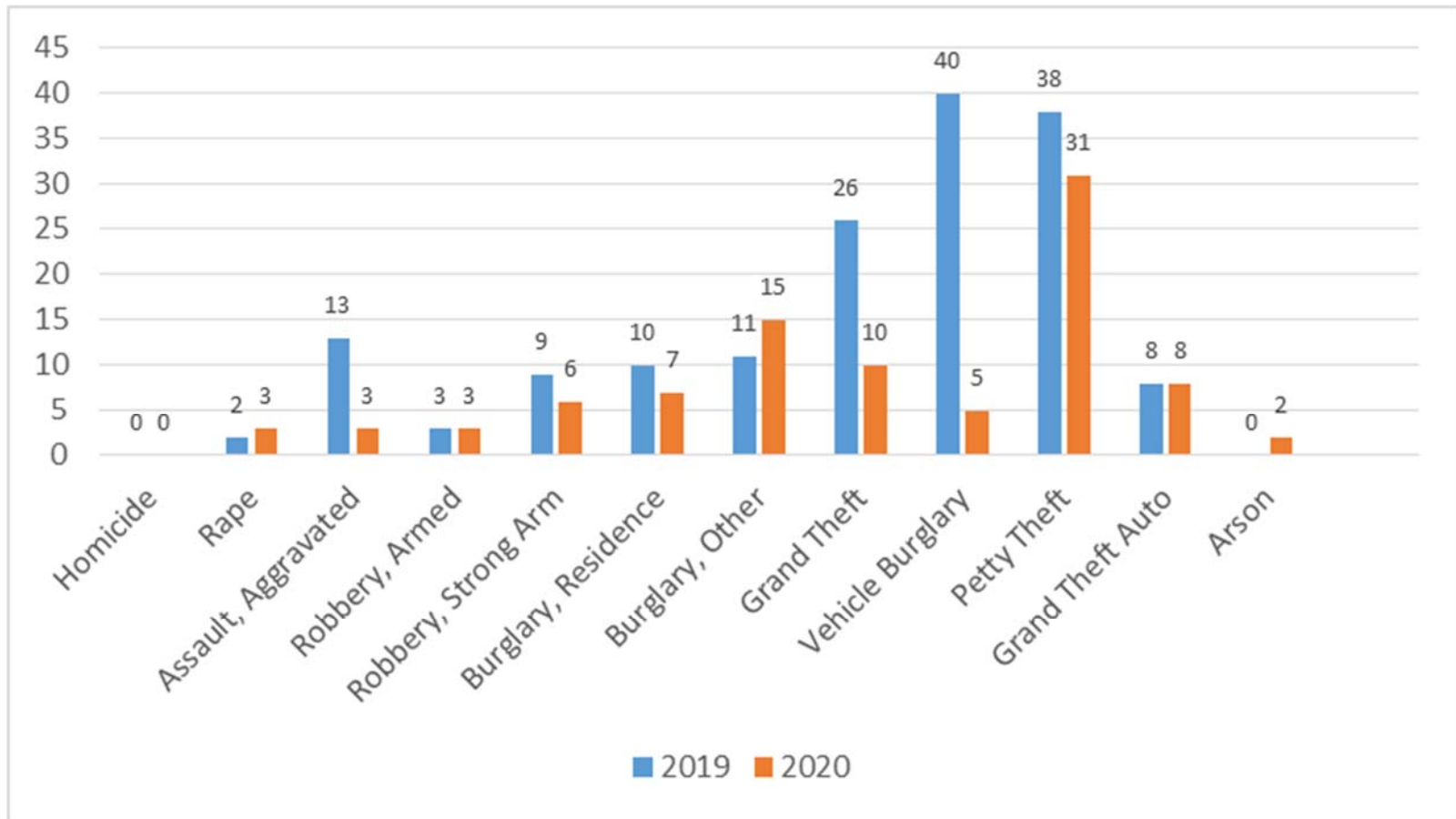

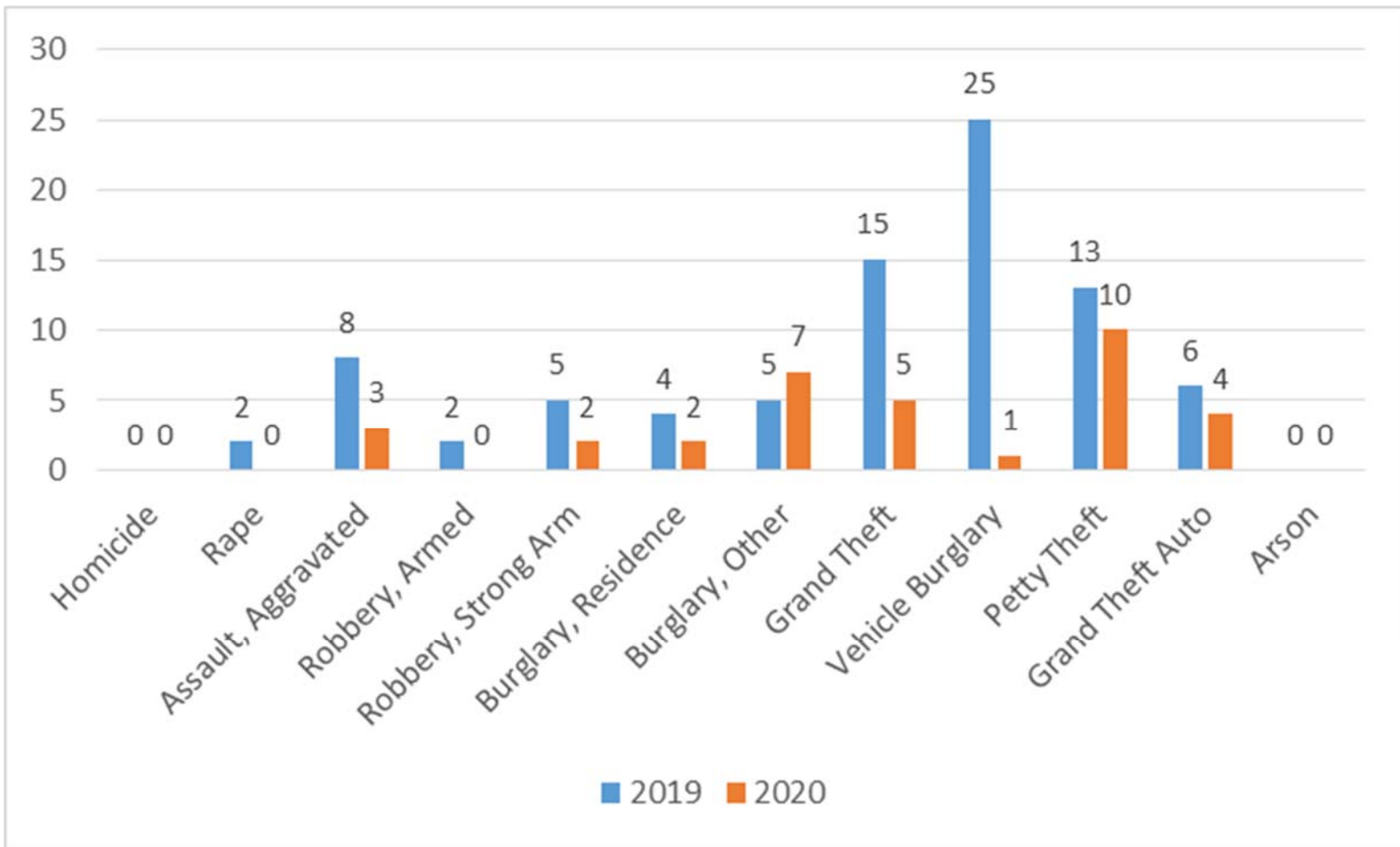


West Hollywood – Whole City Part I Crime September 2019 vs. September 2020





West Hollywood – West District Part I Crime September 2019 vs. September 2020

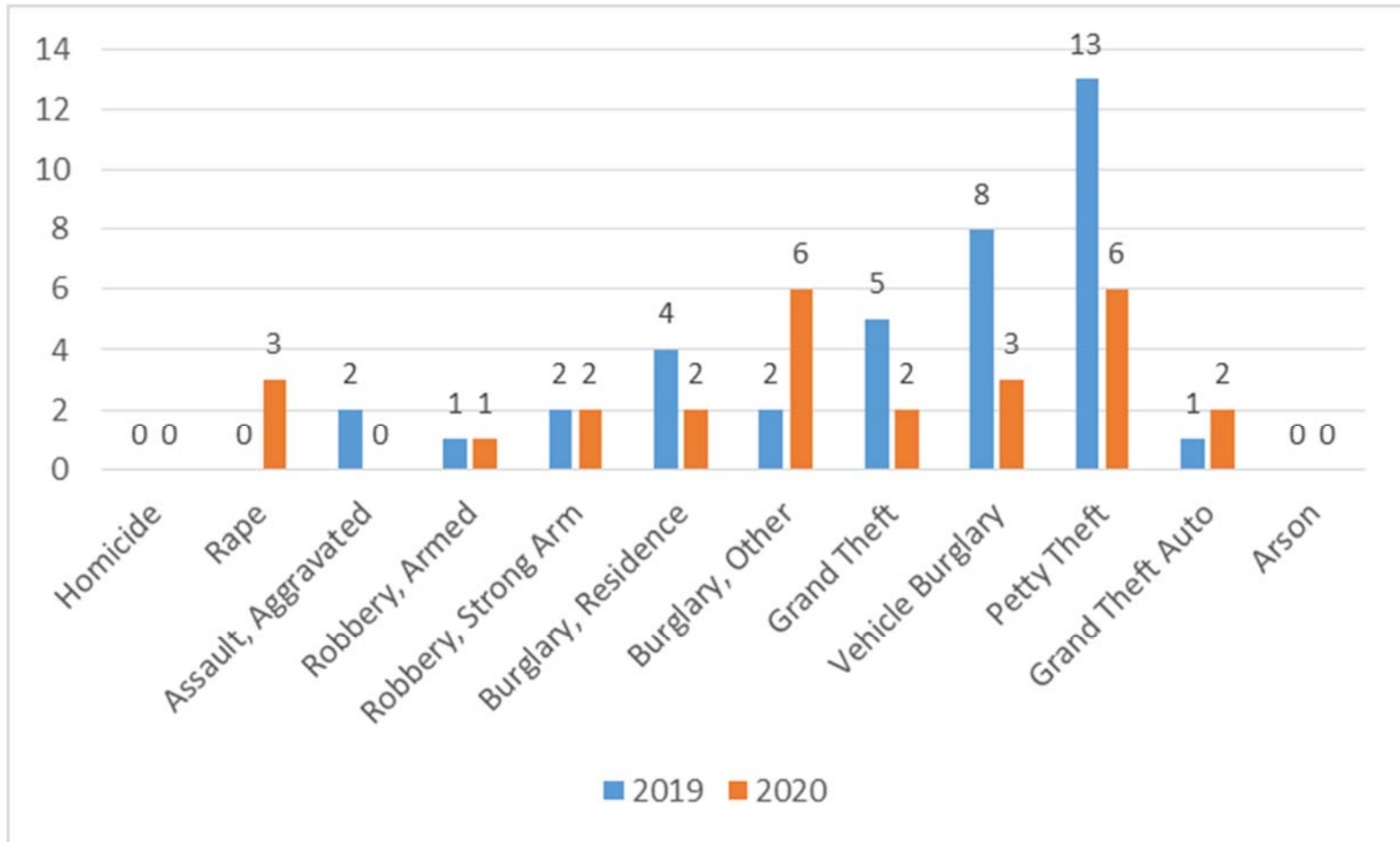

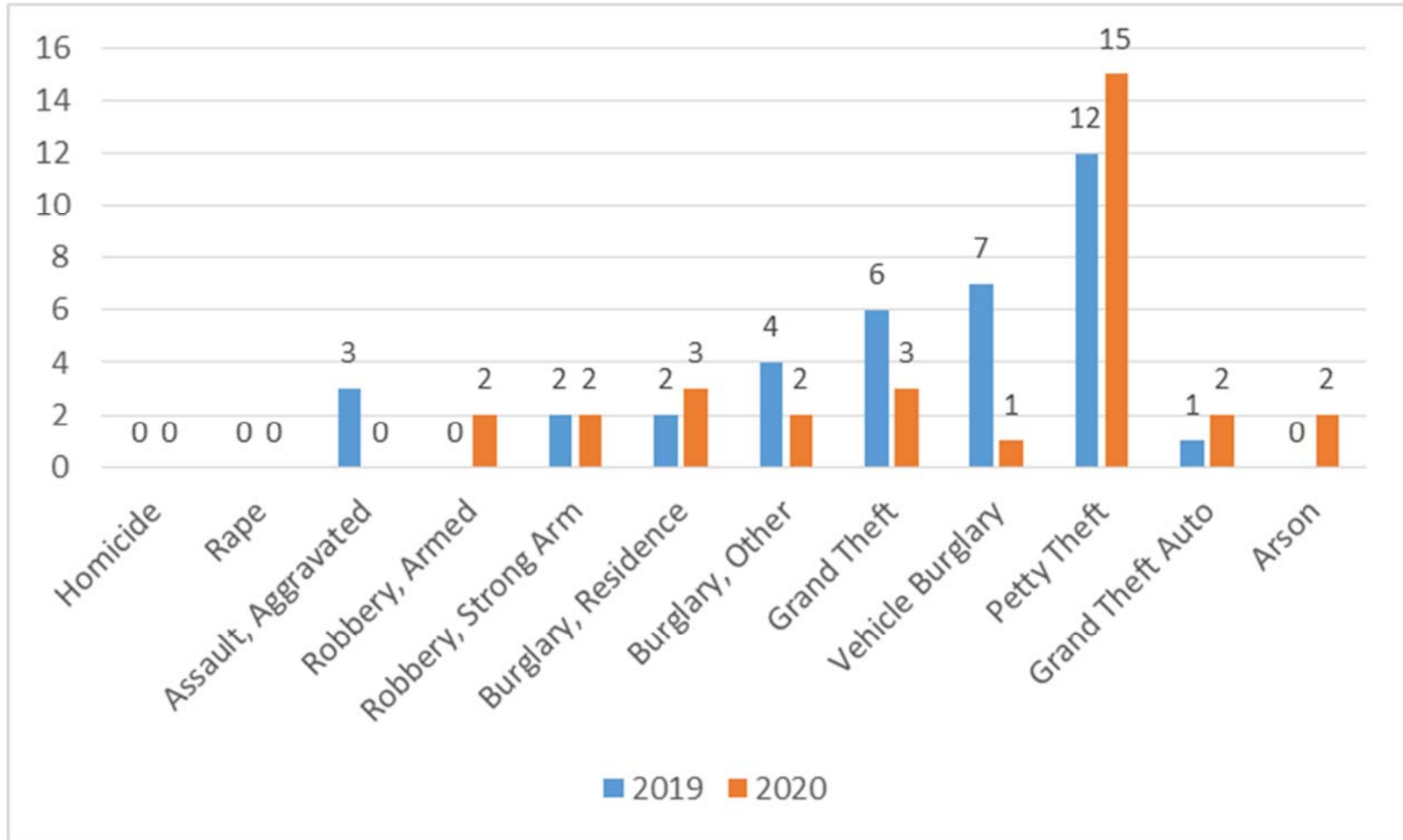


West Hollywood – City Center Part I Crime September 2019 vs. September 2020
