

Important COVID-19 Guidance for Informal Social Gatherings

Update: July 19, 2021

COVID-19 infections are on the rise in LA County.

To reduce the transmission of COVID-19, the Los Angeles County Department of Public Health now requires face coverings in indoor public settings (such as grocery stores) and strongly recommends face coverings in indoor private settings (such as condo and apartment common areas).

Using masks and staying outdoors can help reduce the spread of COVID-19.

Six Tips for Safer Gatherings:

- 1. Cover That Face** – Face coverings are still always safest
- 2. Maintain Your Space** – Use physical distancing
- 3. Size Matters** – Limit quantity of people and households
- 4. Keep Things Short** – Limit the duration of gatherings
- 5. Come Out** – Outdoors is safer than indoors
- 6. Wash Up** – Wash hands frequently and use sanitizers

Stay informed. Follow guidelines. Get vaccinated. Be safe.
