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### ARTS & CULTURAL AFFAIRS COMMISSION

The Arts & Cultural Affairs Commission (formerly the Fine Arts Commission) was created on January 5, 1987 and is comprised of five (5) members appointed by individual Councilmembers and two (2) appointments by the Council as a whole (at-large). Each member of the Commission shall serve a two-year term commencing March 1st following a general municipal election. Members shall have a significant interest in the City such as residency, business or residential ownership, economic involvement, or some other valid link to be determined by the City Council. Members shall not be officers or employees of the City. If a member of the Arts & Cultural Affairs Commission is absent for any reason for more than three regular meetings in any twelve-month period, the office of such member shall be vacated.

The Arts & Cultural Affairs Commission identifies the arts needs of the community and is responsible for analyzing methods of fulfilling these needs and interests and presenting alternative recommendations for actions. The Commission promotes activities to broaden the opportunities for citizen participation in the arts. It acts as a sounding board for individuals and organizations that have an interest in the arts, implements professional evaluation and screening of potential arts activities, and conducts fundraising for the implementation and promotion of the City's arts efforts. The Commission also reviews and approves final arts plans and reviews and advises other Departments, Commissions and Boards on cultural affairs and events.

## BUSINESS LICENSE COMMISSION







The Business License Commission was created on May 4, 1987 and is comprised of five (5) members appointed by individual Councilmembers and two (2) appointments by the Council as a whole (at-large). Each member of the Commission shall serve a two-year term commencing March 1st following a general municipal election. Members shall have a significant interest in the City such as residency, business or residential ownership, economic involvement, or some other valid link to be determined by the City Council. Members shall not be officers or employees of the City. If a member of the Business License Commission is absent for any reason for more than three regular meetings in any twelve-month period, the office of such member shall be vacated.

The Business License Commission shall meet as necessary (but no more than once monthly) to consider modification and/or revocation of business licenses as prescribed in Title 5, Article 1 of the West Hollywood Municipal Code, consider and recommend to the City Council adoption of amendments to the Business License Ordinance and other ordinances and resolutions pertaining to business regulation, and other duties as directed by the City Council.

## DISABILITIES ADVISORY BOARD









The Disabilities Advisory Board was created May 1, 1995 and is comprised of five (5) members appointed by individual Councilmembers and four (4) members appointed by the Council as a whole (at-large). Each member of the Board shall serve a two-year term commencing March 1st following a general municipal election. The City Council shall endeavor to appoint members who represent the specific Advisory Board focus as well as experts in the field. Members shall be reflective of the demographic and geographic diversity of the City. Members should live, work, or have a strong connection to the City. City Council shall have the right to annually appoint a youth (15-18) representative to serve as an ex-officio member of an Advisory Board. If a member of an Advisory Board is absent for any reason for more than three regular meetings in any 12-month period, the office of such member shall be vacated upon the discretion of the City Council.

The Disabilities Advisory Board addresses issues affecting people with disabilities, including ADA compliance, transportation, housing, access to City government and services for people with disabilities, and makes recommendations to Council relative to the adoption of programs, policies or ordinances of benefit to the constituency.

## HISTORIC PRESERVATION COMMISSION

The Historic Preservation Commission (formerly Cultural Heritage Commission) was created on November 6, 1989 and is comprised of five (5) members appointed by individual Councilmembers and two (2) appointments by the Council as a whole (at-large). All members appointed shall serve a two-year term commencing on March 1st following a general election. Members shall have a significant interest in the City such as residency, business or residential ownership, economic involvement or some other valid link to be determined by the City Council. All members of the Commission shall have a demonstrated interest or competence in, or knowledge of, historic preservation and the cultural resources of the City. Commission members shall not be officers or employees of the city. The Commission shall meet no more than once monthly, and if a member of the Commission is absent for any reason for more than three regular meetings in any twelve-month period, the office of such member shall be vacated.

The powers and duties of the Commission are outlined in West Hollywood Municipal Code Section 2.40.080 et seq. and include periodically updating the City's Historic Resources Survey and recommending to the Planning Commission and City Council, the designation of cultural resources including structures, portions of structures, improvements, natural features, landmarks, sites, objects, historic districts, multiple resource or thematic groupings of structures sharing common characteristics or uses.

## HUMAN SERVICES COMMISSION


The Human Services Commission was created on December 5, 1985 and is comprised of five (5) members appointed by individual Councilmembers and two (2) members appointed by the Council as a whole (at-large). Each member of the Commission shall serve a two-year term commencing March 1st following a general municipal election. Members shall have a significant interest in the City such as residency, business or residential ownership, economic involvement, or some other valid link to be determined by the City Council. Members shall not be officers or employees of the City. The Commission shall meet no more than once monthly, and if a member of the Commission is absent for any reason for more than three regular meetings in any twelve-month period, the office of such member shall be vacated.


The Commission shall have the power and be required to: (1) Make recommendations on priorities for development of the city's efforts in Human Service. The program area of Human Services includes Leisure programs, Social programs, Human Rights, and Senior Citizen Affairs; (2) Assist the City Council and Department of Human Services in identifying and determining the Human Service needs of the City. The Commission will cooperate with other agencies in assessing these needs and identifying service gaps; (3) Promote citizen participation in the decision-making process and bring the government process closer to the residents of the City as regards human services programming.

If a member of an Advisory Board is absent for any reason for more than three regular meetings in any 12-month period, the office of such member shall be vacated upon the discretion of the City Council.

The Board addresses matters relating to the Lesbian and Gay community such as education, empowerment, equal rights, hate crimes prevention and domestic partner rights, and makes recommendations to Council relative to the adoption of programs, policies or ordinances of benefit to the constituency.

The Commission shall submit an annual written report to the City Council describing its activities taken pursuant to the Ordinance.

## TRANSPORTATION COMMISSION

The Transportation Commission was created on December 5, 1989 and is comprised of five (5) members appointed by individual Councilmembers and two (2) members appointed by the Council as a whole (at-large). Each member of the Commission shall serve a two-year term commencing March 1st following a general municipal election. Members shall have a significant interest in the City such as residency, business or residential ownership, economic involvement, or some other valid link to be determined by the City Council. Members shall not be officers or employees of the City. The Commission shall meet no more than once monthly, and if a member of the Commission is absent for any reason for more than three regular meetings in any twelve-month period, the office of such member shall be vacated.

The Transportation Commission shall: analyze transportation, transit and parking issues, and make policy recommendations to the City Council; consider alternative transit solutions and make recommendations to the City Council and the Los Angeles County Transportation Commission; analyze and develop regional transportation solutions for West Hollywood's transportation problems; make recommendations to the City Council regarding certain on-street parking controls in accordance with a procedures policy adopted by the City Council; and review any amendments to the Circulation and Traffic Element of the General Plan and make recommendations to the City Council.
