The Commission also reviews and approves final arts plans and reviews and advises other Departments, Commissions and Boards on cultural affairs and events.

The powers and duties of the Commission are outlined in West Hollywood Municipal Code Section 2.40.080 et seq. and include periodically updating the City's Historic Resources Survey and recommending to the Planning Commission and City Council, the designation of cultural resources including structures, portions of structures, improvements, natural features, landmarks, sites, objects, historic districts, multiple resource or thematic groupings of structures sharing common characteristics or uses.

TRANSPORTATION COMMISSION

The Transportation Commission was created on December 5, 1989 and is comprised of five (5) members appointed by individual Councilmembers and two (2) members appointed by the Council as a whole (at-large). Each member of the Commission shall serve a two-year term commencing March 1st following a general municipal election. Members shall have a significant interest in the City such as residency, business or residential ownership, economic involvement, or some other valid link to be determined by the City Council. Members shall not be officers or employees of the City. The Commission shall meet no more than once monthly, and if a member of the Commission is absent for any reason for more than three regular meetings in any twelve-month period, the office of such member shall be vacated.

The Transportation Commission shall: analyze transportation, transit and parking issues, and make policy recommendations to the City Council; consider alternative transit solutions and make recommendations to the City Council and the Los Angeles County Transportation Commission; analyze and develop regional transportation solutions for West Hollywood's transportation problems; make recommendations to the City Council regarding certain on-street parking controls in accordance with a procedures policy adopted by the City Council; and review any amendments to the Circulation and Traffic Element of the General Plan and make recommendations to the City Council.

WOMEN'S ADVISORY BOARD

The Women's Advisory Board was created on December 7, 1992 and is comprised of five (5) members appointed by individual Councilmembers and four (4) members appointed by the Council as a whole (at-large). Each member of the Board shall serve a two-vear term commencing March 1st following a general municipal election. The City Council shall endeavor to appoint members who represent the specific Advisory Board focus, as well experts in the field. Members shall be reflective of the demographic and geographic diversity of the City. Members should live, work, or have a strong connection to the City. City Council shall have the right to annually appoint a youth (15-18) representative to serve as an ex-officio member of an Advisory Board. If a member of an Advisory Board is absent for any reason for more than three regular meetings in any 12-month period, the office of such member shall be vacated upon the discretion of the City Council.

The Women's Advisory Board addresses matters relating to advocacy on behalf of women's rights such as economic equality, reproductive rights, violence against women and sexual harassment and makes recommendations to Council relative to the adoption of programs, policies or ordinances of benefit to the constituency.
