Board Member Paris gave a summary of the Lesbian and Gay Advisory Board and Transgender Advisory Board joint subcommittee meeting.

Co-Chair Wright spoke about the importance of selfcare and care of others in the hurried return to normalcy.

Co-Chair Gamboa asked that the Board adjourn in memory of all the community members that we lost to COVID-19 in the past month. He talked about the Matthew B. Palazzolo Memorial Scholarship Fund and the Matthew B. Palazzolo LGBTQ Equity Fund. He commented on the death of Ali Fazeli Monfared.
