NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the West Hollywood City Council will hold a public hearing on **MONDAY, August 16, 2021**, to hear anyone wishing to speak regarding the introduction on first reading to adopt an ordinance that requires restaurants, food or beverage providers, retail vendors, or retail food vendors to distribute plastic utensils and plastic beverage straws only upon request by the customer, adds violations of the new chapter to the list of Municipal Code chapters and sections that are subject to the administrative penalty procedures, and amends the Master Fee Resolution for Fiscal Year 2021-22 to include violations to the Administrative Citation Fee Schedule.
