7. PUBLIC COMMENT

Miss Tiger, CITY OF WEST HOLLYWOOD, spoke about what inspired them to join the Board.

Genevieve Morrill, CITY OF WEST HOLLYWOOD, spoke about Gay Pride Events Contract.

Dean Ambrosini, CITY OF WEST HOLLYWOOD, introduced himself as the new Prevention Coordinator for the West Hollywood Project.

K. Bradford, CITY OF WEST HOLLYWOOD, spoke about WALK THE WALK: A COMMUNITY THEATER PROJECT featuring rans, gnc, nonbinary, intersex community members on June 23 and 30.

8. BOARD MEMBER COMMENTS

Board Member Deitch announced the date of Simi Valley Pride on June 26, 2021, spoke about the AIDS Memorial groundbreaking, and expressed disappointment about the Board not being notified of notable gay events in the city.

Board Member Sotile asked that the Board adjourn in memory of composer, Peter Fish and in memory of Janie the community cat.

Board Member Miss Tiger thanked the Board for their work and service.

Board Member Frazier welcomed Miss Tiger and asked that the Board adjourn in memory of members of the Trans Community that were murdered in the past month; Danika "Danny" Henson, Serenity Hollis, Oliver "Ollie" Taylor, Thomas Hardin and Poe Black.

Board Member Francesca welcomed Miss Tiger and expressed disappointment about feeling that the LGAB has been left out of several City events.

Co-Chair Gamboa agreed with Board Member Francesca, welcomed Miss Tiger and invited new board members, including since 2020, to meet in person with the co-chairs over coffee.

Co-Chair Wright gave a shout out to Board Members Francesca and Steele for their work on events that have benefitted several community charities.

11. B. TRANSGENDER FLAG IN CROSSWALKS

The Lesbian and Gay Advisory Board received a brief report from the City's Engineering Division, which has been directed by the City Council to gather input from the Transgender Advisory Board, the Lesbian and Gay Advisory Board, and the Transportation Commission on the preferred intersection along Santa Monica Boulevard to place the transgender flag on crosswalks.

The Board discussed various options for flag placement and various flag designs.

ACTION: Recommend that the Progressive Flag be placed at La Cienega/Santa Monica & Robertson/Santa Monica intersections and the Transgender flag at San Vicente/Santa Monica.
