REVIEW THE CRIMINAL BACKGROUND CHECK RESULTS FOR THE OFFICERS AND DIRECTORS OF THE PARENT COMPANY AND CONSIDER UNCONDITIONAL FINAL APPROVAL OF THE PREVIOUS VARIANCE REQUEST, PURSUANT TO SECTION 5 OF THE PREVIOUSLY APPROVED CONDITIONAL VARIANCE REQUEST REGARDING THE TRANSFER OF EIGHTY-FIVE PERCENT (85%) OWNERSHIP IN THE CALMA CANNABIS ADULT-USE AND CANNABIS DELIVERY LICENSES TO THE PARENT COMPANY
