As a representative of the City, you will work with business owners and residents to protect the quality of life for residents while balancing the needs of businesses and residents. Interacting with a variety of world-renowned businesses, including event venues, restaurants and hotels, this position independently performs complex technical functions related to code compliance and regulatory business license enforcement including: receiving code violation complaints and conducting investigations, notifying property/business owners of violations and explaining required corrections. Some key responsibilities may include: monitoring special events, interacting with a variety of high-level individuals, preparing and maintaining case documentation for prosecution of violators, and conducting nighttime compliance investigations with staff and law enforcement personnel.

The Code Enforcement function is a seven-day-a-week operation that provides service to the community from 7 a.m. to 3 a.m. This position will require a set schedule (Wednesday through Sunday) until 3 a.m., on holidays and during major events (e.g. Pride or Halloween), or to cover a shift during the week (Monday through Wednesday) when needed. Please note: a 10% increase in hourly pay is assigned to all hours worked between 6:00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m., and holiday pay is paid one-and-onehalf (1 $\frac{1}{2}$) times the regular hourly rate of pay.

Ideal Candidate:

- Current public sector experience with background/knowledge in code enforcement functions. Strong interpersonal and customer service skills.
- Ability to effectively deal with conflict and difficult interactions.
- This position requires demonstrated experience in identifying, investigating, and resolving code compliance complaints and violations.
- Possesses a California POST Penal Code 832 and Code Enforcement Officer Certification (desirable).
