### PROFESSIONAL PHOTOGRAPHY SERVICES — PROJECT DESCRIPTION

From time to time, the City of West Hollywood requires experienced professional photography support for a wide array of City projects, initiatives, and programs. The City is currently gathering qualifications from interested photography professionals to establish a pool of individuals who can provide such services to the City on an as-needed basis.

Examples of needed ongoing photography services include:

- Indoor and outdoor small-scale events such as: presentations, speeches, meetings, and ceremonies
- Outdoor large-scale events such as the June WeHo Pride Festival and Parade and the October Halloween Carnaval
- Group and individual portraits
- Architecture and urban environments
- Event/on site photos and/or video of people interacting at special events
- Posed photos of groups at events
- Lifestyle and aerial photography
- Image post-production

Professional photographers who submit qualifications should also have skills and capacity to deliver digital files within 24 hours of shooting. The City's preferred method for receiving images is in electronic format — either through a high-speed download portal (preferred) or through high-capacity disk (CD, DVD or flashdrive).

Professional photographers and videographers should have experience in:

- Providing high-resolution images/footage suitable for various types of print media
- Providing photos/footage at a resolution more suitable for online use (i.e. social media, websites, etc.)
- Providing photos in a jpg format
- Managing quality control processes (vetting images and footage to ensure color and contrast balance) prior to delivery.
- Managing quality control processes to ensure the usability of images and footage (focus, subjects' eyes open, etc.).



### **ELIGIBILITY**

This Request for Qualifications is open to experienced professional photographers with demonstrated training and experience in professional photo capture and production, and professional photographers who submit qualifications should have provision of all equipment including camera, tripod, lighting, light meter, memory cards, card reader, and any other equipment required for general assignments.

### **SELECTION PROCESS**

City of West Hollywood Communications Department staff will convene a panel to review submissions through this Request for Qualifications.

The City's Communications Department serves as the office of primary responsibility for day-to-day hiring and management of professional photographers. All photos submitted will be subject to editing and production notes by the City's Communications Department.

### SCHEDULE + BUDGET

Should prospective photography professionals be considered for project(s), the City will issue a contract for services. The issuance of a contract is not a guarantee of work. Rather, it is a necessary qualification. Following the establishment of a contract, project(s) may be assigned on an as-needed basis and each project will require an approved scope of work with estimated hours, rate/fee, not-to-exceed amount, and a purchase order issued by the City's Finance Department before work may begin. The consultant will be required to have and maintain general liability and auto insurance for the contract period to meet the minimum requirements established by the City. Prior to commencing work, the consultant must attend an orientation with Communications Department staff.
