INTRODUCTION

The Department of Public Works' solid waste and recycling program has three primary responsibilities: solid waste collection and recycling which is provided under an exclusive franchise agreement for the entire City, issuing permits to and regulating haulers who provide large containers described as "roll off" containers for construction and demolition waste generated at development sites, and educational programs that inform the public regarding the benefits of recycling and reducing the amount of waste produced.

The City levies an annual charge on the property tax bill for solid waste collection and recycling services on residential parcels within the City. The other responsibilities of the Department of Public Works are funded from other sources.

This report explains the solid waste collection and recycling charges proposed to be levied on residential and commercial parcels for Fiscal Year 2022/2023.

PRIOR AND CURRENT YEAR ANNUAL CHARGES

On November 3, 2014, the City entered into a franchise agreement with a private waste contract hauler, Athens Services, for citywide solid waste collection and recycling services. The City contracts with Athens Services for household trash and curbside recycling services for single family residential parcels with one to four units, as well as recycling services for multi-unit residential parcels with five or more units. Commercial parcels and multi-unit residential parcels with five or more units contract directly with the contract hauler for trash collection services. The City bills single family residential parcels with one to four units for solid waste services by placing the charges onto the property tax roll. Beginning July 1, 2022, Athens Services will directly bill multi-family and commercial customers. Solid waste charges vary based on the number of containers and frequency of collection services for the parcel.

Pursuant to West Hollywood Municipal Code section 15.48.010, residential customers are subject to a City Solid Waste Collection Fee and City Recycling Fee. The City Solid Waste Collection Fee is the direct charge paid to Athens Services. The City Recycling Fee (also referred to herein as the "City Administrative Fee") is the indirect charge that is an allocation of the Department of Public Works and other City Departments' efforts to manage the solid waste and recycling program. These indirect costs include staff, rent, utilities, outreach, trainings and other costs. All property owners pay the City's indirect charges on the annual property tax bill. For properties with less than 5 units, the City collects Athens Services' trash and recycling fees on the property tax bill and passes these fees onto the Hauler.

In Fall 2021, Athens Services requested changes in their contract to provide the services required by regulations promulgated by CalRecycle to implement SB 1383 (Chapter 395, Statutes of 2016), related to the reduction of Short-Lived Climate Pollutants. On June 27, 2022, the

franchise agreement with Athens Services contract will be amended to include organic waste collection services and a rate increase to cover the costs of solid waste, recycling, and organic waste collection services. The rate increase will be necessary to implement state mandates related to the SB 1383 requirements and increased costs for solid waste services.

ANNUAL INCREASES

Because the costs of providing solid waste, recycling and organics services may increase over time due to inflation, the annual rate adjustment effective July 1, 2022 shall consist of a CPI inflationary adjustment for services in Exhibit A, a supplemental adjustment, and a CPI adjustment to City Administrative Fee as described below.

Annual CPI Adjustment

For the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2023, and annually thereafter on July 1 through and including July 1, 2026, the maximum rates provided in Exhibit A shall be automatically adjusted annually based upon the annual percentage change March to March in the CPI for Trash and Garbage Collection (CUUR0000SEHG02), United States City Average (not seasonally adjusted), as determined by the United States Department of Labor Statistics, plus 1%.

The 2021/2022 actual and proposed 2022/2023 City Solid Waste Collection Fees and City Recycling Fees are shown in the following table.

A summary of charges by land uses including the high, low, and average assessments for the land use class are attached as Exhibit B. The complete roll showing all parcels and charges is on file in the City Clerk's office and incorporated herein by this reference.

Supplemental Adjustment

In addition to the CPI adjustment, a supplemental adjustment shall be applied, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2023, and annually thereafter on July 1 through and including July 1, 2026, as follows:

Beginning Rate Period	Supplemental Increase
July 1, 2023	+ 10.4%
July 1, 2024	+ 7.5%
July 1, 2025	+ 5.3%
July 1, 2026	+ 3.6%

Except for the City Administrative Fee, the maximum total annual adjustment of rates shall be the percentage of the annual CPI adjustment plus the annual supplemental adjustment. In other words, CPI adjustment + supplemental adjustment = maximum total annual adjustment. The maximum rates in Exhibit A, except for the City Administrative Fee, shall be adjusted each July 1 by multiplying the rates by the maximum total annual adjustment (as a percentage).

City Administrative Fee Adjustment

For the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2023, and annually thereafter on July 1 through and including July 1, 2026, the maximum rate of the "City Administrative Fee" in Exhibit A shall be automatically adjusted based upon the annual percentage change January to January in the CPI, All Urban Consumers for the Los Angeles-Long Beach-Anaheim, CA Metropolitan Area (not seasonally adjusted), as determined by the United States Department of Labor Statistics. However, the City Administrative Fee shall not be increased by more than 10% in any fiscal year.

PROPOSITION 218 CONSIDERATIONS

Proposition 218 was approved by the voters of the State of California on November 6, 1996 contains requirements for the imposition of a fee or charge for property-related services. Procedures for the adoption of property-related fees and charges are contained in Section 6 of Article XIII D. The City Council will conduct a public hearing regarding the adoption of

increased solid waste charges at its June 27, 2022 Council meeting.

Pursuant to Proposition 218, fees or charges must comply with the following five conditions:

- (1) Revenues shall not exceed the funds required to provide the service.
- (2) Revenues shall not be used for any other purpose for than that for which the fee or charge was imposed.
- (3) The amount of the fee or charge imposed upon any parcel or person as an incident of property ownership shall not exceed the proportional cost of the service attributable to the parcel.
- (4) No fee or charge may be imposed unless the service is actually used by or immediately available to the property.
- (5) No fee or charge shall be imposed for general governmental services, i.e., police, fire, ambulance, library, where the service is available to the public at large in substantially the same manner as it is to the property owners
- 1) Government Code Section 53756 allows the City to authorize automatic adjustments to property-related charges that are clearly defined by a formula for adjusting for inflation and are for a period not to exceed five years. The multi-year adjustments for inflation have already been approved by the City Council. The only change to the Hauler's rates for FY 2022-27 will be for inflation, which by its very nature covers the increased costs of living and doing business as a result of normal economic conditions and thus will not exceed the cost of providing service.
- 2) Revenues are held separate from other City funds and only used for the solid waste, recycling, and organic waste program.
- 3) Rates are based on the services attributed for residential parcels with 1 to 4 units. Rates are based on the land use code and number of units for trash and recycling services.
- 4) Revenue collected from residential parcels on the property tax bill is based on the County Assessor's records. The City has a program in place for property owners to apply for reimbursement of any payments charged for vacant units.
- 5) Funds for solid waste collection and recycling are specific services provided to each

parcel. The City uses other funds for general services to the public at large.

We conclude that the City of West Hollywood City Solid Waste Collection Fee and City Recycling Fee as described in this report satisfies the requirements outline above.

The list of the description of each parcel of real property receiving services and the amount of the charge for each parcel for the year, identified as "FY23 Solid Waste Tax Roll" is on file with the City Clerk and incorporated herein by this reference.
