Base Value is the dollar amount assigned to one cross-section unit (square inch or square centimeter) of a tree's trunk cross-section area. Cross-Section Area is used to express tree size. Species Class is an assigned value based on all the landscape merits of a landscape tree species and its accompanying potential for problems. Condition Class is a factor indicating the health, vigor and life expectancy of a tree, as well as its quality of form relative to a "perfect specimen" of that species.
