B. Arts Grant Program – 2023 Community Arts Grant Application Review

RECOMMENDATIONS:

- 2) Recommend that the Arts and Cultural Affairs Commission approve funding for a maximum of three (3) individual artist grants of \$5,000 each for calendar year 2023.
