STUDY SESSION: INTERIM ZONING ORDINANCE

Woody Tescher announced that they would like to walk through the new version of the Ordinance. There are two new sections, Movie Studios and Design Standards. The Council should schedule another meeting for parking, as that will be a lenghthy discussion. They commenced their discussion on Page 25, CG General Commercial Zone.

The discussion on the Draft Interim Zoning Ordinance covered the following:

CHAPTER 9240 -CG GENERAL COMMERCIAL ZONE

ACTION: At the recommendation of Envicom, to remove "subject to the provisions of Section 9516.3 of Chapter 9510", from 9244-A-1 (page 26).

Woody Tescher and Mark Winogrond were requested to come back to the Council with suggestions on major and minor Conditional Use Permits.

CHAPTER 9250 -CM COMMERCIAL MANUFACTURING ZONE

ACTIONS: Section 9252 - Permitted Uses renumber Warehousing and distribution facilities as Item 3: In section 9255 -Development Standards, reduce maximum building height to 45 feet (page 32).

CHAPTER 9260 -MS MOVIE STUDIO ZONE

ACTIONS: Section 9264 - Development Standards - Change maximum building height to 45 feet (page 35).

CHAPTER 9270 -P PUBLIC ZONE

ACTIONS: None

CHAPTER 9300 -ESTABLISHMENT OF OVERLAY DISTRICTS ACTIONS: None

CHAPTER 9310 -PO PROFESSIONAL OFFICE OVERLAY

CHAPTER 9320 -RO RENTAL OPPORTUNITY OVERLAY

ACTIONS: Discussion centered on "of up to 75 units per net acre". There did not seem to be a concensus on the Council but it was brought out that 50 units per net acre was standard throughout Los Angeles and that this is a bonus and does not include inclusionary housing. Mayor Heilman felt the Council needed more information, and they should look at an incremental increase in inclusionary housing. (page 41)

CHAPTER 9330 -PK FARKING OVERLAY ACTIONS: The concensus of the Council seemed to be that they would like to see the consultant and staff come back with options and alternatives. The concern was with the demolition of housing, and the trade off of housing vs parking. (page 42)
